

ORDINANCE NO. 2008- 07

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERDALE
AMENDING TITLE 10, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"
IN THE VILLAGE OF RIVERDALE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Riverdale is as Home Rule Municipality within the purview of Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution (1970), and the said Village, therefore, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverdale, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter 10.110 entitled "Vehicle Impoundment Procedures for Vehicles involved in Certain Violations", Sec.10.110.020 entitled "Conduct Prohibited" is hereby deleted in its entirety and in lieu thereof, the following Sec. 10.110.020 is inserted:

Sec. 10.110.020 Conduct Prohibited. A motor vehicle that is used in connection with any of the following violations may be subject to seizure and impoundment by the Village, and the owner of record of the vehicle shall be liable to the Village for an administrative penalty of up to five hundred dollars (\$500.00) plus any applicable towing fees: the violation of the criminal code of 1961, 720 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/9-1, 5/9-3.3, 5/11-6, 5/11-14, 5/11-15, 5/11-15.1, 5/11-16, 5/11-17, 5/11-18, 5/11-18.1, 5/11-19, 5/11-19.1, 5/11-19.2, 5/12-2, 5/12-3, 5/12-3.2, 5/12-4, 5/12-4.1, 5/12-4.2, 5/12-4.3, 5/12-4.4, 5/12-4.6, 5/12-4.7, 5/12-6, 5/12-7.1, 5/12-7.3, 5/12-7.4, 5/12-11, 5/12-11.1, 5/12-13, 5/12-14, 5/12-15, 5/12-16, 5/12-16.2, 5/18-1, 5/18-2, 5/18-3, 5/18-4, 5/18-5, 5/19-1, 5/19-2, 5/19-3, 5/19-4, 5/19-5, 5/20-1, 5/20-1.1, 5/20-2, 5/21-1, 5/21-2, 5/21-3, 5/21-4, 5/21-5, 5/21-6, 5/24-1, 5/24-1.2, 5/24-1.2-5, 5/24-1.5, 5/24-1.6, 5/24-2.1, 5/24-3.1, 5/24-3.3, 5/24-3.4, 5/24-3.5, 5/26-5, 5/33A-2, 130/2a, 150/5.1, or in violation of 720 Illinois Compiled Statutes 550/4, 550/5, 550/5.1, 550/5.2, 550/8 of the cannabis control act or in violation of 720 Illinois Compiled Statutes 570/401, 570/401.1, 570/402 and 570/404 of the controlled substance act (or similar provision of local ordinance) or in violation of 430 Illinois Compiled Statutes 65/0.01 of the Fire Arms Code or in violation of 625 Illinois Compiled Statutes, 5/4-104a, 5/11-501, 5/11-502, 5/6-303, 5/6-101, 5/11-204, 5/11-204.1, 5/11-401A, 5/11-503c 5/11-504 of the vehicle code or in violation of Section 10.77 of the Riverdale Municipal Code, shall be subject to seizure and impoundment.

Exception

1. Violation of 625 Illinois Compiled Statutes where the suspension is due to a vehicle emissions suspension and said suspension has not been imposed for more than one (1) year at the time of the stop.

2. Violation of 625 Illinois Compiled Statutes where the drivers license has not been expired for more than six (6) months at the time of the stop.

SECTION 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form.
